

**2007 UINTAH COUNTY FAIR FOOD EATING CONTEST
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM**

DIVISIONS

There will be 4 different divisions with 3 rounds in each event. A women and a mens division ages 12-18 and a women and a mens division ages 19 and up. There will be 3 winners in each division. The first place winner will receive \$50.00, second place \$30.00 and third place \$20.00.

CONTEST EATING RULES:

Each division will start with 8 contestants. In round 1 each contestant will have 3 minutes to eat as many hot dogs with buns as they can. After round 1, 2 contestants will be asked to leave. In round 2 the remaining 6 contestants will have 3 minutes to eat as many donuts as they can. After round 2, 2 more contestants will be asked to leave. In round 3, the remaining 4 contestants will have 5 minutes to eat ice cream and drink a 2 liter bottle of root beer. There will be 5 minutes in-between rounds. Contestant's must keep all food submerged for a period of two minutes after each round.

The rules of this contest allow for food items to be separated, dunked, mushed, and mashed in an effort to consume the most hot dogs and donuts in the allowed time frame..

Contestants will be given five hot dogs and buns to start. There will be two cups of water for dunking or drinking (save room for the root beer). When the last of the five hot dogs is in process of consumption, five more will be placed before the contestant. The same with the donuts.

Should a contestant be observed hiding their hot dogs or donuts, dropping them under the table, or placing them on another person's plate, or spilling the root beer he/she will be deemed in performance of a "picnic profanity" and will be disqualified.

Contestant's who suffer a reversal of fortune and/or urges contrary to swallowing will be disqualified (and possibly laughed at).

The "Chipmunking Rule" will be in effect, which means that all food to count must be swallowed 30 seconds after the buzzer.

Gurgitators who are found to be in violation of the "Chipmunking Rule" will be penalized ½ a hot dog or donut.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by a 3 minute hot dog eat-off with the winner being the one who consumes the most.

Creative participation is strongly encouraged, but good sportsmanship is required.

Decision by judges is final!

Each registrant MUST sign the liability waiver and release. (See page 2).

Acknowledgment of Risks and Waiver of Liability: Contestant acknowledges that there are risks of personal injury, illness and possible loss of life, and risks of damage to or loss of personal property, which may result from participating in this contest. Contestant voluntarily enters contest and assumes all of these risks. Contestant, as a condition of entry, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Uintah County, and all officers, directors, employees and agents of the aforesaid entities, from any and all claims and costs, including attorneys' fees, arising from or in connection with participation in this contest or the receipt or use of any prize. In so doing, contestant releases and indemnifies the aforesaid entities and individuals from liability for injuries or damages of any kind arising from or in connection with participation in this contest or the receipt or use of any prize, except where such claims or costs arise out of the indemnified party's gross negligence.

Certification and Signature: I certify that the information provided is correct and that I have carefully read, understand and accept the terms of the Uintah County Fair Food Eating Contest Official Contest Rules and Entry Form.
