RULES OF ENTRY

1. Open to all horses and exhibitors.
2. Points given: 1st place – 6 points; 2nd place – 5 points; 3rd place – 4 points; 4th place – 3 points; 5th place – 2 points; entering but not placing 1 point.
3. N.S.C.A., W.S.C.A., & 4-H rules will apply with some changes necessary for an open show.
4. Judges, timers and rules committee decisions will be final.
5. We reserve the right to combine classes if only one horse is entered. A horse and/or rider can be entered only once in each class except the 11 & Under age group. These riders may share the same horse. Exceptions are Showmanship and Western Horsemanship classes; it is impossible to share the same horse in these events.
6. High Point awards are based on one horse and one rider as a team.
7. In all timed events, touching or steadying any prop is an automatic disqualification. Knock down of a prop is a 5 second penalty. Crossing back over the start line before completing a pattern will turn off the timer and will be a broken pattern, which is a disqualification.
8. All other entries close for the class when the previous class goes through the gate.
9. Western attire is required in all JUDGED WESTERN PERFORMANCE classes, including western boots, long sleeved shirt, belt, and hat. In ENGLISH classes English tack and attire is required. In TIMED EVENTS a short sleeved Western shirt or t-shirt is allowed and western boots with heels are required.
10. Helmets are mandatory for the 15 & Under riders in the timed events.
11. Stallions may not be shown by a 15 & Under exhibitor.
12. Rules and Patterns will be posted one hour before the show.
13. Showmanship at halter is a judged performance class.
14. Contestants in Lead line Equitation may not enter the Western Horsemanship 11 & Under class.
15. There will be no refunds.
16. Two-handed training horses can only be shown in two-handed training classes.
17. Age of two-handed training horse is five years old or younger. They may be shown in a bosal or snaffle (egg-butt, o-ring, or D-ring).
18. All Halter horses must be signed up by 8:45 sharp!
19. Age Jan. 1, 2011 determines age group.
20. After three calls by the announcer, the gate will be closed for the class
