**Show opens with the Parade of the Athletes (the Strutting of the Mutts), followed by judged classes:**

## 1. Kindred Spirits

The dog and owner who look most alike take the gold.

## 2. The Odd Couple

Which dog and owner look the most mismatched?

## 3. Ball Toss

BYOB (ball or balls, of course) for your dog to chase, catch, and bring back.

## 4. Nadia Comaneci Agility

Your dog **and you** navigate a course that includes low jumps, a tunnel crawl, see-saw, etc. Separate judging for handlers age 12 and under / 13 and over.

## 5. Terrific Tricks

The canine talent competition. Separate judging for handlers age 12 and under / 13 and over.

## 6. Dunking for Dogs

Who can eat the floating hot dog chunks the fastest?

## 7. Luciano Pavarotti Commemorative Sing-Off

From opera to country, this is for the best canine vocalist.

## 8. Babe Ruth Obedience Baseball

For a home run, your dog must obey a command at each base. Separate judging for handlers age 12 and under / 13 and over.

## 9. Peanut Butter Lick

How fast can your dog clean the peanut butter off a spoon?

## 10. Frisbee Throw

Show off your discus skills, and your dog's talent at mid-air catching.

## 11. Who's Your Daddy

Special for the mixed breeds – the more mixed-up or mysterious parentage, the better.

## 12. Rip Van Winkle Sleep-Off

Practice your "Down Stay" in advance, then show that your dog can lie still the longest.

## 13. Smoochiest Pooches

Kissing up to handlers and/or judges is encouraged!

## Best in Show

Winners of all classes assemble for judging the Best in Show Purebred and Best in Show Mixed Breed.

## Rules of entry:

1. Open to human contestants of all ages.
2. Open to dogs of all breeds, pure or mixed.
3. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age.
4. Dogs must be current on all shots.
5. Dog costumes must not restrict dog's natural motion.
6. All dogs must have a collar and leash and be kept leashed at all times, except while performing in Class 3, 5, 8, or 10.
7. No dogs in heat are allowed.
8. No award of any kind will be given to a dog in poor physical condition.
9. Any dog behaving aggressively toward humans or other dogs will be required to leave.
10. Any dog shown must be the pet of its handler (foster dogs excepted).
11. Judge's decision is final.
